FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Coral Gables Campus and Gables One Tower: Parking Enforcement Hours Extended To 7-Days/week 8 a.m. – 11 p.m.

FACULTY, STAFF, STUDENT, THIRD PARTY VENDORS

Why the change in policy?

To create a consistent and more 'equitable' practice by having all campus parkers share in the financial responsibility of paying for the parking resource that they use; reduce the 'unknown' parker by requiring all parkers to register their vehicle's license plate with the university; and, augment 'security' after-hours with parking enforcement officers patrolling the lots.

I have a Daytime Permit, do I need to purchase a Nights and Weekend Permit?

No. The Daytime Permits are valid 24-hours/7-days a week/365 days.

What are the enforcement hours?

Effective August 20, 2018, 8 a.m. – 11 p.m./7-days a week, excluding University holidays.

Who is required to have the Nights and Weekend Permit?

Faculty, staff and students who park at the university M-F, from 4 p.m. – 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. on weekends.

What is the cost of the Nights and Weekend Permit?

- a. <u>August 20, 2018 August 15, 2019</u>: The cost of the permit is \$260 for the 2018-19 Academic year. The cost of the permit will be waived for Faculty, students, staff and third party vendors during the 2018-19 Academic year to help with the transition into this new policy. However, Faculty, students, staff and third party vendors are required to obtain this permit to avoid parking violations.
- b. <u>Subsequent years:</u> Subject to the usual annual increase of approximately \$5-8.

Where do I park with the Nights and Weekend Permit? Do the color zones apply?

The Night and Weekend permit is valid M-F, from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. on weekends in all parking zones (except: Preferred, Reserved, Service and metered spaces).

Can I park in the purple zone after 4 p.m. M-F and on weekends?

Yes, with any UM permit or PayByPhone.

Can I park and use PayByPhone in any zone after 4 p.m. M-F and on weekends?

Yes.

I am Faculty/staff and participate in the official University Public Transit Program, and drive my car to campus occasionally at nights and/or weekends. Do I need to purchase the Night & Weekend Permit?

Contact Parking & Transportation to review your available options.

Where do I purchase the Nights and Weekend Permit?

The permit will be available for purchase during the July 2018 Permit Season Sale. You may purchase it from Parking & Transportation via online www.miami.edu/parking or visiting the offices located at 5807 Ponce de Leon Blvd.

What is the parking cost using PayByPhone or the On-foot Pay Stations?

<u>PayByPhone:</u> The hourly rate is \$1.50, plus .27 cents per transaction. For example, if you estimate 2-hours of parking, the total cost will be \$3.27. If you extend your parking session by 1-hour, this is considered a new transaction and the incremental cost will be \$1.77 (\$1.50 + .27).

On-foot Pay Stations: The hourly rate is \$1.50; there is no additional transaction fee.

Do other universities charge for weeknights and weekend parking?

Yes. Many other Universities have this practice.

Do you plan to increase the PayByPhone parking hourly rate? If yes, how soon?

The rate of \$1.50 will remain in place for one year. We will reevaluate on a yearly basis and adjust as needed.

NIGHTS AND WEEKEND PARKING PERMITS AVAILABLE

The following permits will be created for Nights and Weekend to meet business needs. Permits will be valid M-F 4 p.m. to 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. on weekends/365 days. The 2018-19 Academic year cost is:

- a. Nights and Weekend \$260
- b. Faculty/Adjuncts/Staff with UM Salary of \$35,000 or less \$130
- c. Motorcycle \$54
- d. Intercampus \$61
- e. Commuter Fall-Only \$130
- f. Wellness Center \$54
