



Note: Park only in designated spaces (enforced 24 hours a day). Park head-in only, unless a front-mounted plate is displayed. UM parking permit is required seven days a week, 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. Color restrictions are enforced Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. PayByPhone is available throughout campus. Restrictions apply. Note: Future changes to lots and parking structures are anticipated; parking in these areas may be unavailable due to construction. Smoking is prohibited throughout the Coral Gables campus.



Campus Parking

Permit Parking (Students, Faculty, and Staff)

All vehicles regularly parked on the Coral Gables campus must be registered with the University of Miami Parking and Transportation office and have a valid University parking permit. Parking permits are virtual and linked to your vehicle's license plate. All vehicles must be parked head-in only, unless a front-mounted plate is displayed. A permit is required to park on campus from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. seven days a week.

Parking lots are identified by color. Vehicles must park in the color zone that corresponds to their assigned permit color Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. The color restrictions are lifted after 4 p.m. on weekdays and at any time during the weekend.

Visitor Parking

Hourly Parking: Visitors may use the visitor area of the Pavia Garage (pink zone) or anywhere in the yellow, gray, or burgundy zones. Purchase time at any pay machine or via PayByPhone.

Short-Term Passes (one to five days): Visitors may obtain short-term passes at the pay machines located in the Merrick Garage, Pavia Garage, Herbert Wellness Center, and yellow and gray zones. Day passes also can be purchased online at miami.edu/daypass. The PayByPhone system can be used to purchase a day pass one day at a time.

Long-Term Visitor Permits: Visitors who park on campus regularly but do not qualify for other parking permits may apply for a long-term visitor permit from the Parking and Transportation office, subject to availability.

Bicycle Parking

We welcome bicycles and provide ample bicycle parking throughout campus. We require all bicycles to be registered with the University of Miami Police Department and secured with a U-lock, which will be provided by the police during the registration process. To register your bicycle, please bring it to the police department, located in the Filipe Building. The University's bicycle policies are available at miami.edu/police.

Zipcar Program

Zipcar is an innovative car-sharing program that provides the convenience of having a car on campus without the commitment of car ownership. Zipcar members, 18 years and older, may rent a vehicle for an hour, a whole day, or longer for a small fee that includes fuel, insurance, and maintenance.

Hurry 'Canes Shuttle Service

The shuttle is available without charge to all University students, faculty, and staff and serves major areas of the University as well as the University Metrorail station and Rosenstiel School campus. It facilitates the use of perimeter parking lots and provides a convenient means of traveling around campus without using a personal vehicle. The shuttles run every seven to nine minutes during class days and every 15 to 20 minutes all other times.

The Hurry 'Canes Shuttle does not operate on University of Miami designated holidays.

Schedules are posted in the shuttle stops, Rosenstiel campus drop-off location, Hurry 'Canes shuttles, and at miami.edu/mobility.
