

Campus Parking Guide

1. **One vehicle only**—Only one vehicle can be parked on campus per day. To add a vehicle to your account, visit the Office of Parking and Transportation with valid vehicle owner registration.



2. **Mind your colors**—Park only in your assigned color zone.



3. **Visitors**—Use PayByPhone and parking pay stations for hourly and daily parking sessions. For weekly or monthly passes, visit the Office of Parking and Transportation. Restrictions apply.



4. **Head-in only**—Properly display your license plate toward the drive aisle. If you don't have a front bumper license plate, do not back into a parking space.



5. **Reserved**—General parking permits are not valid in metered, loading, service, or reserved spaces—24 hours a day, seven days a week.



6. **No parking zones**—Avoid “No Parking” zones, including areas blocking service drives, streets, or fire lanes.



7. **Take charge**—Park your EV in a charging stall only when actively charging, up to four hours. A valid permit or visitor's pass is required.



8. **Take public transit**—Ride the Metrorail/Metrobus, Tri-Rail, or Brightline to campus using discounts for students and employees.



9. **Use human power**—Park your bike or skateboard (registered with University of Miami Police Department) at designated racks.



10. **Zip around**—Sign up for a Zipcar membership and rent a vehicle on campus when needed.
